

Learning Lizards: Topic Web

Science

This term we will be looking at forces and how they influence our lives. What a balanced and unbalanced force is, what air and water resistance is and how to identify it. Plus we will be learning about friction and the impact of levers and pulleys.

PSHE

Our focus this term is Being Healthy. We will look at ways to stay healthy, how we can create a 'healthy school environment' and what this means.

History

This term, we will place the three prehistoric eras on a timeline, explore the changes in the Bronze Age to the Iron Age. We will also discover the importance of the wheel and axle and when the Iron Age came to an end and why.

Music

In music, we will be looking at how well we can explore beat and rhythm. We will learn what this means and identify this in different genres of music. Playing body percussion and moving to the beat.

Computing

In computing this half term our topic is called 'Game developers'. We will be focussing upon what makes a successful computer game and create our own games using Scratch. We begin every half term with a focus in E-safety. How to stay safe online and how to report any problems.

Maths

In maths, the children will be focussing on place value and the mental and written methods linked with the four operations with Miss Ireland. Within in this we will learn about rounding, comparing and ordering numbers, negative numbers and Roman Numerals. Mrs Webster will be teaching the children position and direction including reflection and translation.

RE

This term we will be looking at 'Why do some people believe God exists?' In this unit we will learn about what the Christian and Jewish faiths believe. We will refer to stories from the bible and discuss if people need to prove God's existence.

English

We will start the term by writing a historical narrative based upon the Bronze Age and Iron Age. We will then move onto writing a recount linked to everyday in the prehistoric eras.

PE

Outdoor PE will be on a Monday and Friday this term. We will be focusing upon the 'Personal' cog of REAL PE. Children will reflect upon their skill level and how they managed to improve their performance of these skills such as passing, throwing, turn taking and striking.

Art

In art we will be learning how to use marks and line to produce texture. We will use shading, tone and shape to represent movement in a piece of work. We will focus upon each technique before combing these skills to make a Pre historic inspired composition.
