



Letter Race

How to play: Set up the magnetic board on one side of the room, and place the magnetic letters in a basket or bowl on the other side. Call out a sound, or a word starting or ending in a particular sound. Then ask your child (with a ready, set, go!) to pick out the correct magnetic letters and run over as fast as they can to stick it on the board.

Resources Included: 1 instruction card

Resources needed from home: a magnetic board, magnetic letters, and a lot of space.

Key skills involved in this game: Letter/sound recognition, sound isolation

Vocabulary/key questions to ask: sound, phoneme, grapheme.

Extra challenge: Can you find the letters to make cvc words such as cat, cup, mat, nit, not etc.
