



Number Bonds

How to play: Cut out the number cards and with a partner lay all of the cards spread out upside down on a flat surface. Play like memory - take turns to turn over two cards each. The aim is to find a pair with numbers that add to ten. If the two numbers on the cards do not add to ten, turn them back over in the same place. For example if you turn over a 6 and a 4 you would get to keep them as they add to ten. The person with gets the most pairs wins the game.

Resources Included: 1 instruction card, 1 set of number bond cards

Resources needed from home: scissors

Key skills involved in this game: Relate addition to counting on and recognise that addition can be done in any order.

Vocabulary/key questions to ask: together, total, number bonds, pair.

Extra challenge: Can you think of any number bonds to 20?
