



# What's the Time?

**How to play:** Use the question card and see if you can answer the questions about time.

**Resources Included:** 1 instruction card, 1 question card.

**Resources needed from home:** a clock or a watch

**Key skills involved in this game:** Use every day language related to time, measure short periods of time in simple ways.

**Vocabulary/key questions to ask:** clock, time, o'clock, numbers 1-12, clock face, hands, hour, minute, seconds, before, after.

**Extra challenge:** Can you draw some pictures of what you do at the start, the middle, and the end of the day?

Can you read the numbers around the edge of the clock face?



Can you point to the hands on the clock?



Where does the big hand point when it is 'o'clock'?



What time do you go to bed?



What time does school start?



Can you count to 60 as the second hand goes around?



How many jumps can you do in one minute?



How many times can you write your name in one minute?



How many times can you turn around in one minute?
