



Sound I Spy

How to play: 'I Spy the Sound' is a fun way to build phonics skills and phonemic awareness. In this variation of the classic game, 'I Spy', ask your child to spy words that begin with a certain sound, rather than a letter. For example, "I spy with my little eye, something beginning with mmm."

Resources Included: 1 instruction card

Resources needed from home: objects

Key skills involved in this game: Letter/sound recognition, sound isolation, initial sound isolation.

Vocabulary/key questions to ask: sound, phoneme, grapheme.

Extra challenge: Can you tell me the end/middle sounds in the word?
