





<p>11.00 – 11.30</p>	<p>Maths</p>		<p>Re-cap yesterday’s learning. And go through the different coins again.</p> <p>Show the children price tags with the following amounts;</p> <p>3p 4p 6p 8p</p> <p>And for children who got this concept yesterday</p> <p>14p 22p</p> <p>Explain that we don’t have a 3p so we need to add together the coins to make this total. How many 1ps would we need to make this? Show you counting out the 3p’s. Repeat with the next totals. Stick with just using 1p’s at first but if your child get the hang of it you could introduce 20p and a 2 p makes 22p.</p> <p>Complete the following worksheet. Choose the one most suited to your child’s ability based on the task above.</p>

<p>1.20 – 2.00</p>	<p>Topic/Creative</p>		<p>Outside Learning- Play the outdoor memory game.</p> <p>Go for a nature walk and collect 5-15 objects from nature. Try to choose objects with distinctly different features and textures, for example tree nuts, leaves, sticks, feathers, rocks and flowers.</p> <p>Spread out the white sheet or a blanket on the ground and place all the items in front of your child. You may wish to start with 5 at first. Give them a couple of minutes to memorize the objects, then put the blindfold on.</p> <p>Remove one of the objects, then remove your child’s blindfold. Ask them to guess what is missing. You could take it in turns to guess.</p>
