





1.00 – 1.20	Reading		<p>10 minutes on Rising stars website with assigned book. Talk about what you have already read. What could happen next> Who is your favorite character? Are you enjoying the book so far? Why/why not?</p>
1.20 – 2.00	Topic/Creative		<p>RE- Our World- Think about the story we looked at last week. What was the story about?</p> <p>Recap last week’s learning where we played the caring for creature’s game. Are there any other creatures we saw/heard in the environment when we went outside on or hunt? Discuss.</p> <p>Explain that today we are going to talk about birds. Why are birds important to our environment? Explain that birds eat lots of insects, especially in the spring when they're feeding their babies too. This helps stop too many insects come into our gardens and homes. Seed-eating birds such as finches and sparrows help to create a healthy garden by keeping weeds from taking over.</p> <p>Explain that we are going to care for birds today by making a bird feeder. This will depend on what you have at home. You could either string cheerios onto pipe cleaners.</p>

			 <p>Or you could cut out a shape from cardboard, spread it with peanut butter and then stick bird seed to this.</p> <p>Put them outside to see what birds come and eat from them.</p>
